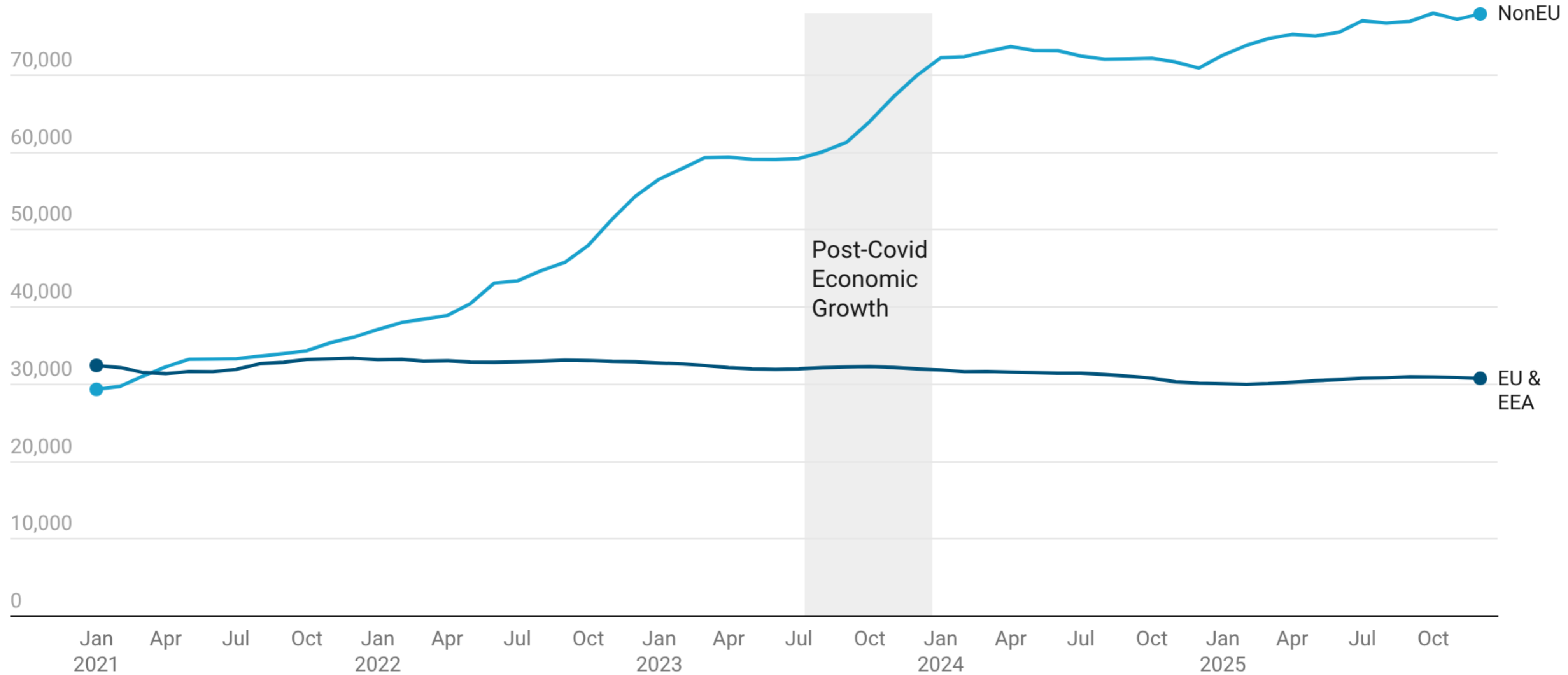

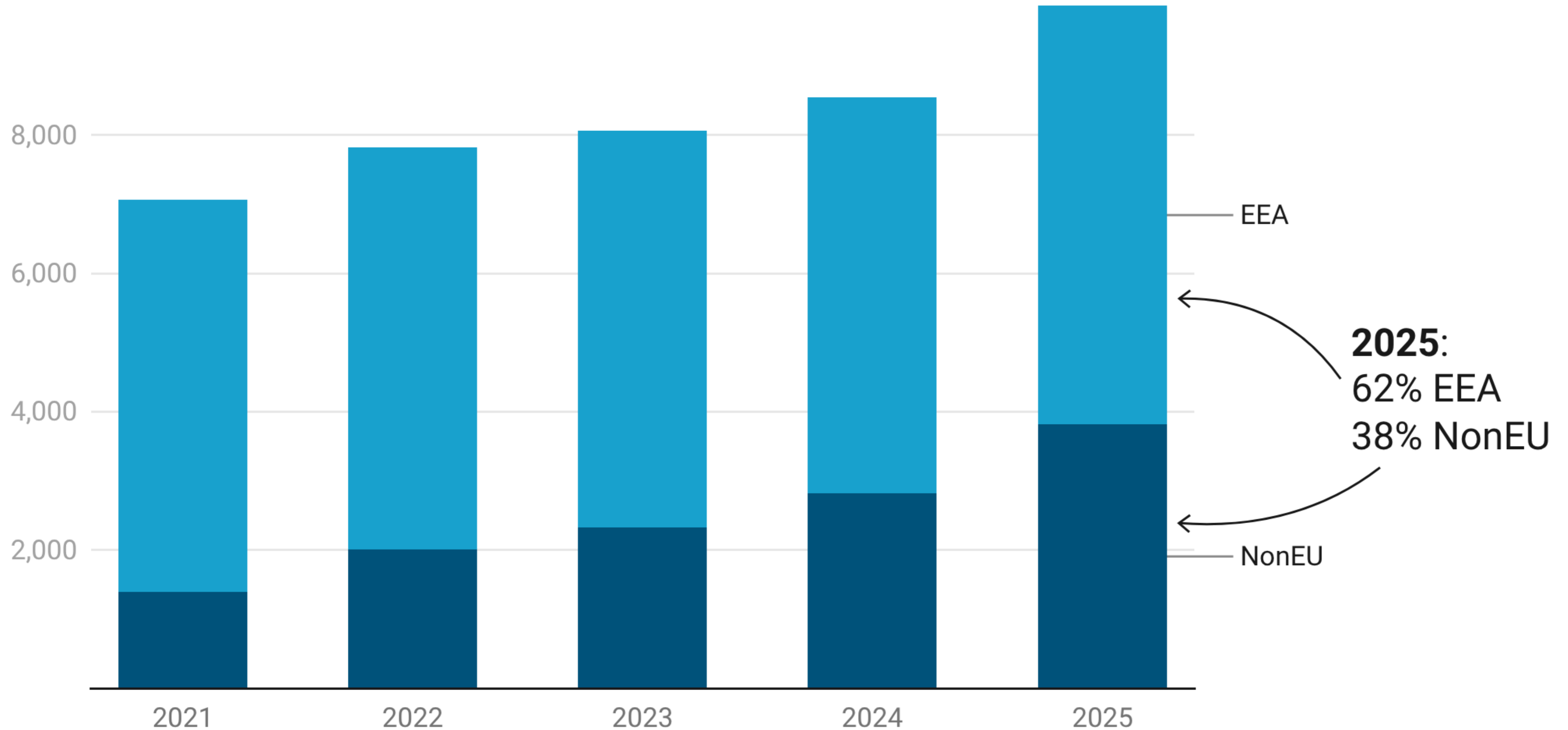

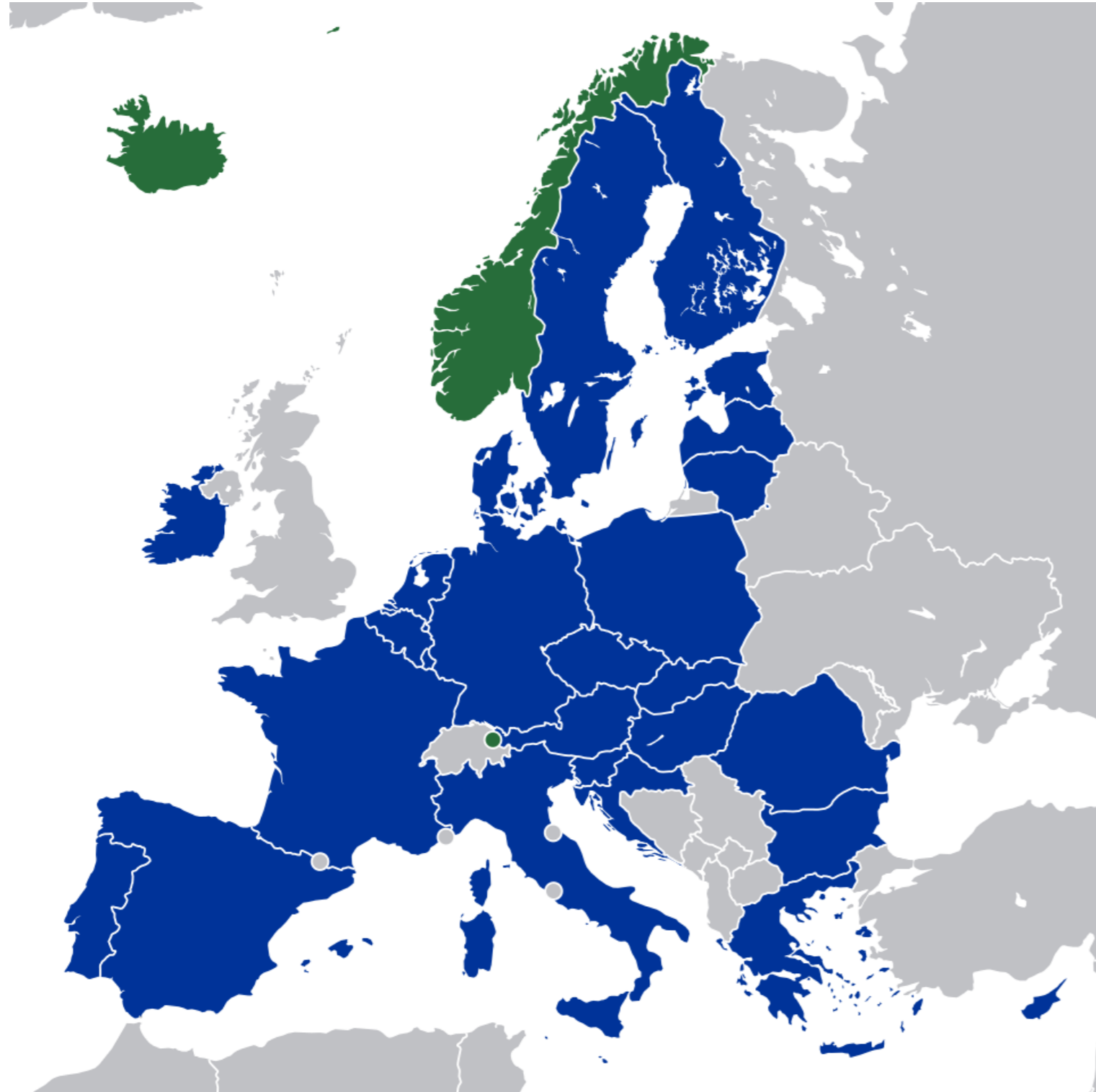

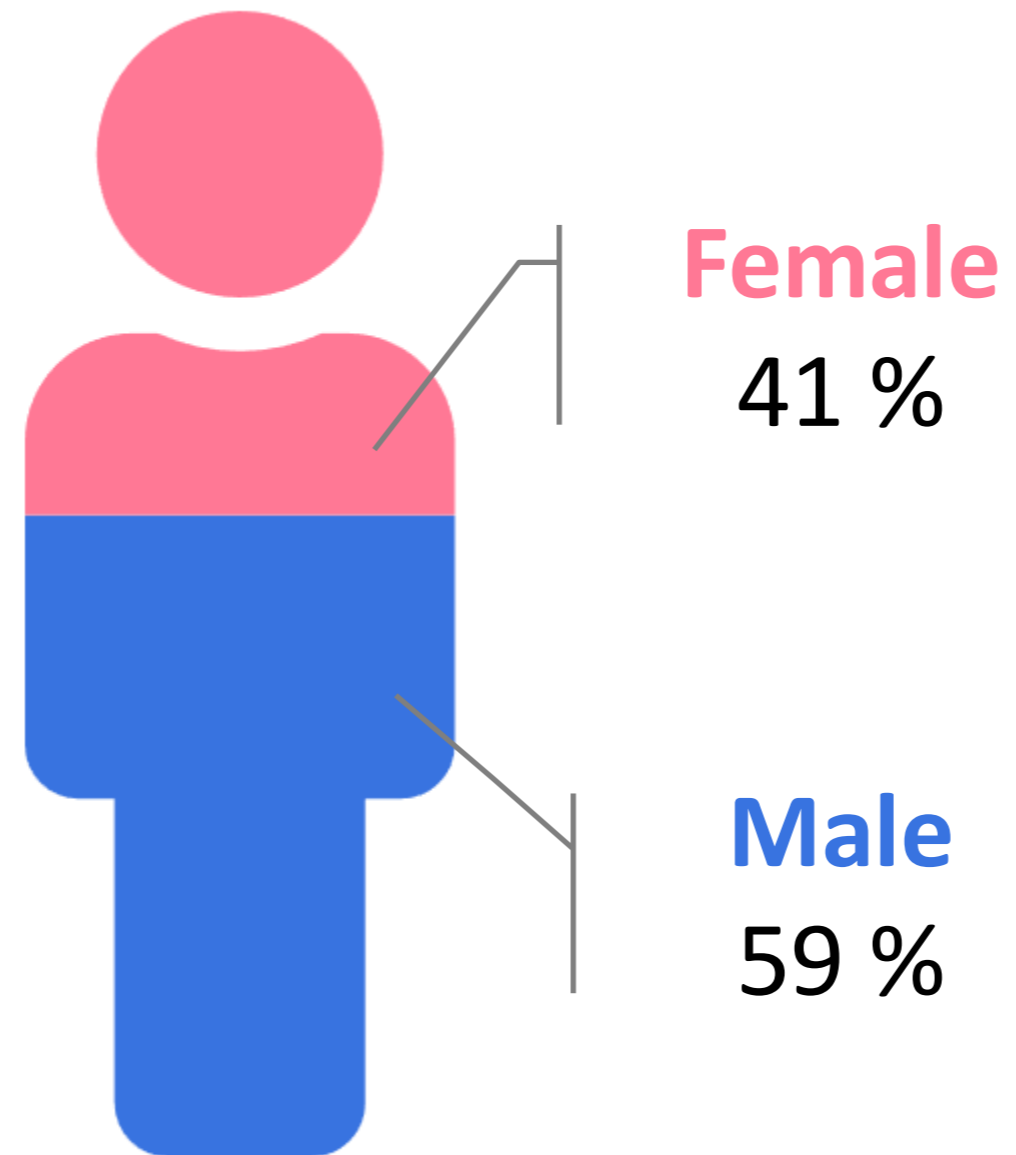

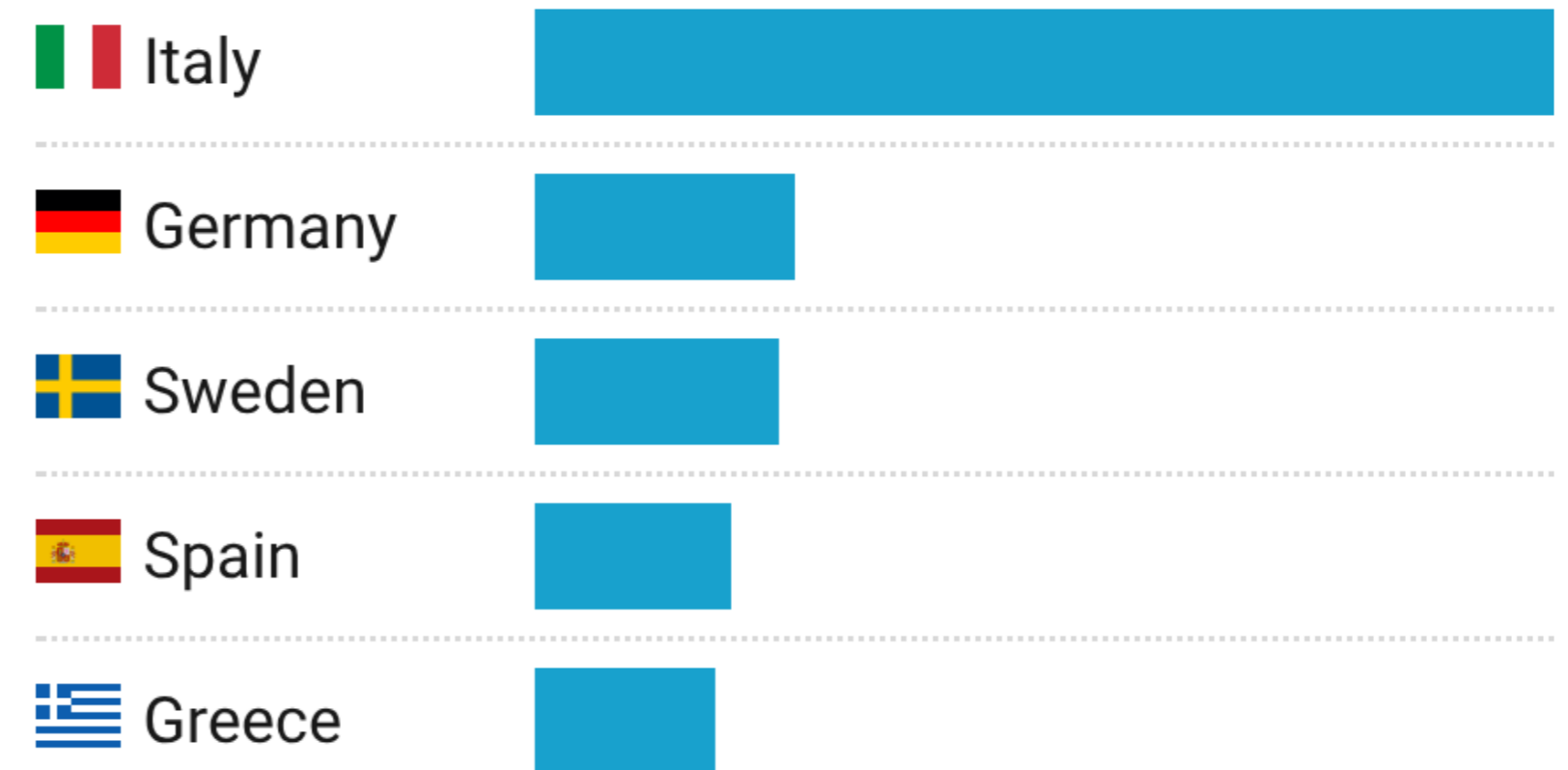
# Population pyramid



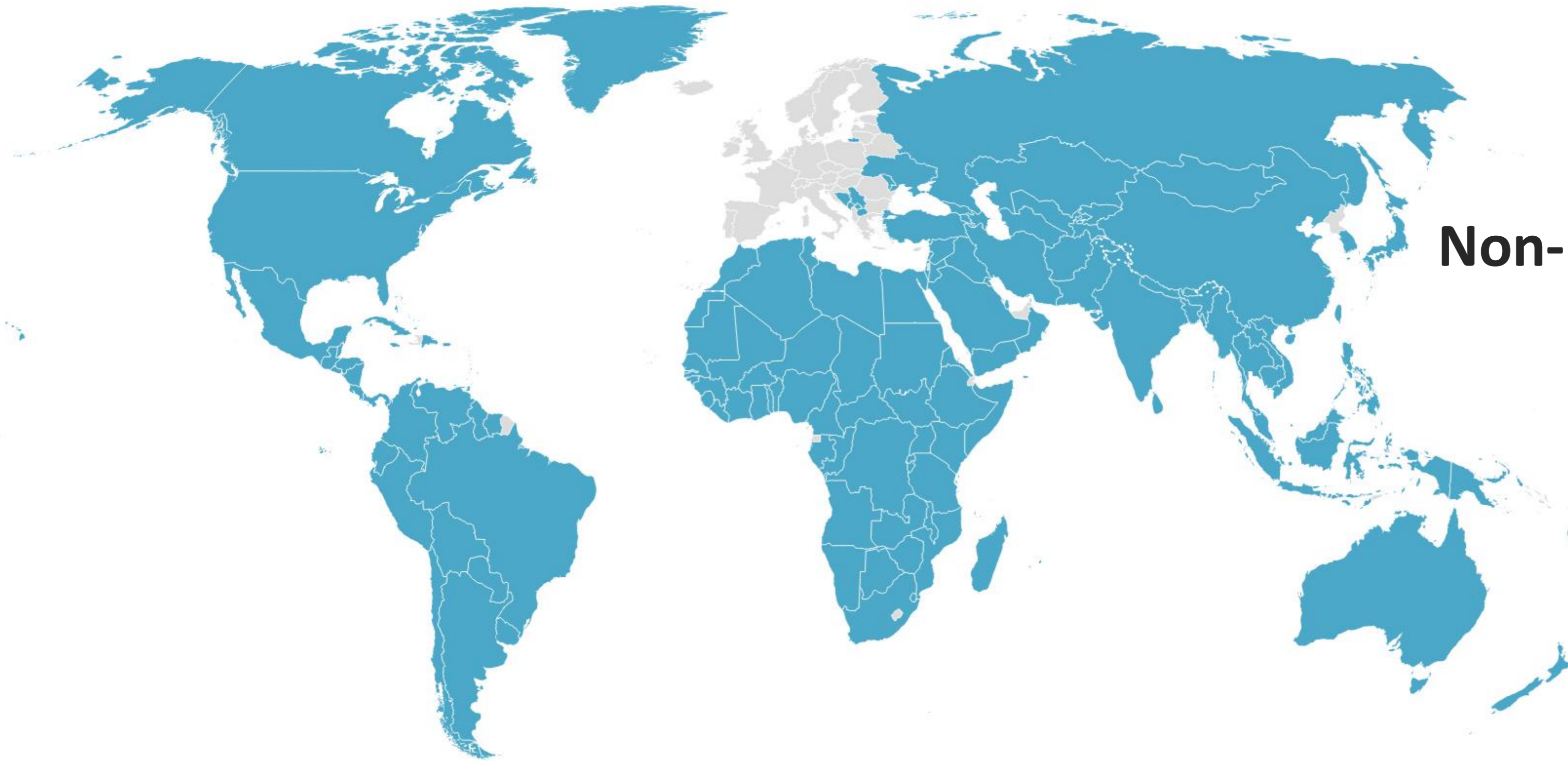


## Typical EU/EEA Worker

Most common nationalities are **Italian**, followed by **German, Swedish, Spanish and Greek**.

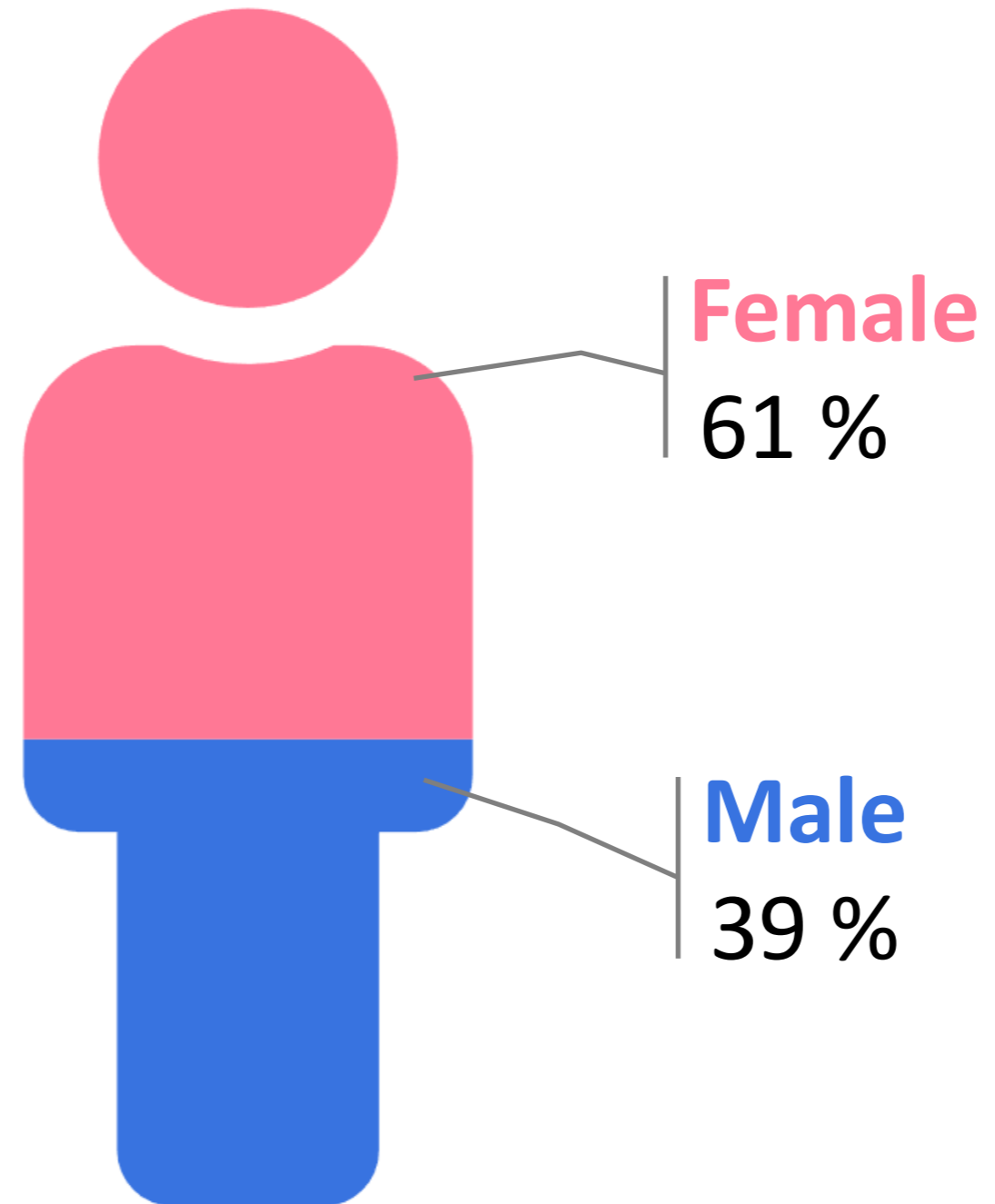

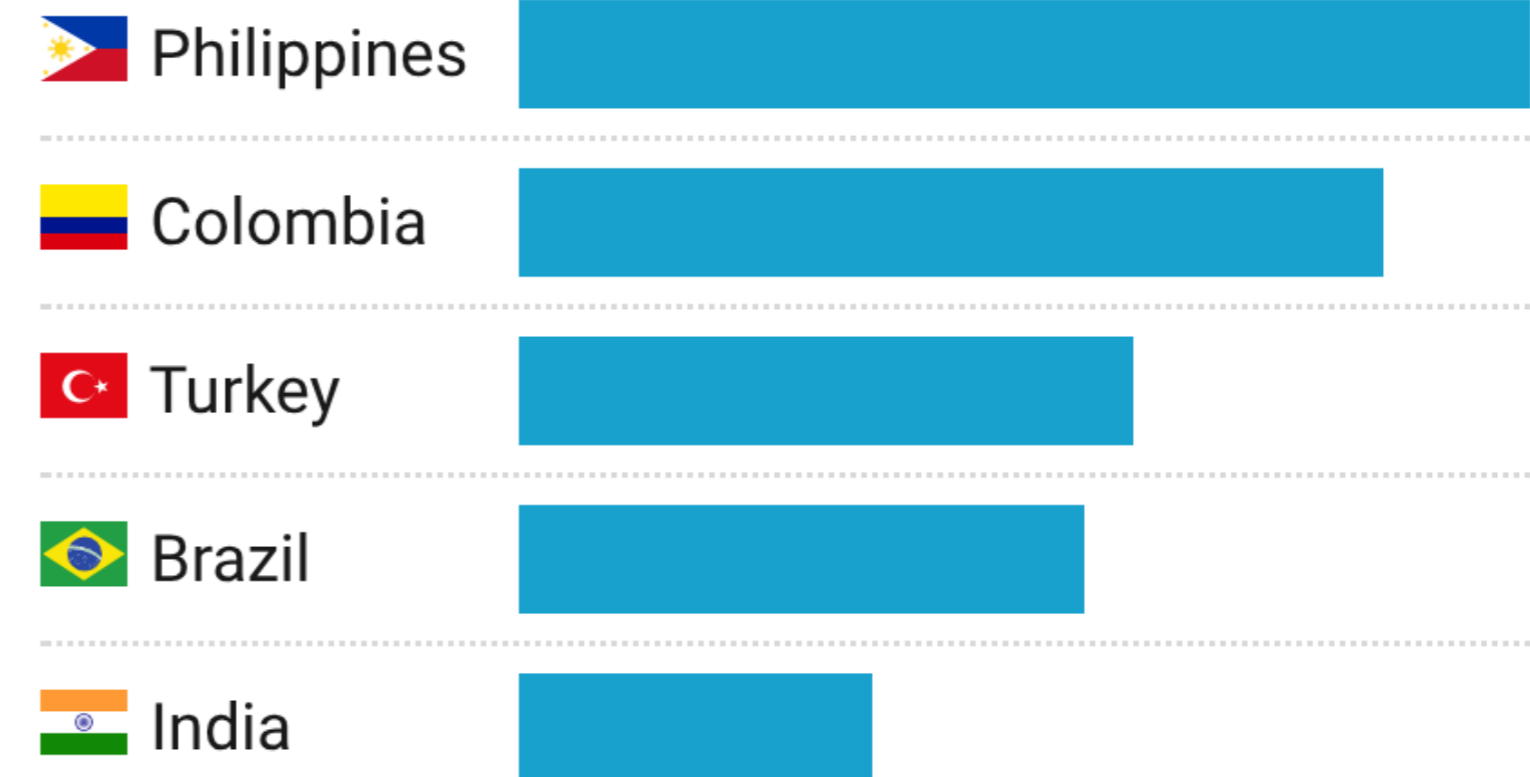

The top NON-EU worker nationalities are **Filipinos, Colombians, Turkish, Brazilians and Indians.**

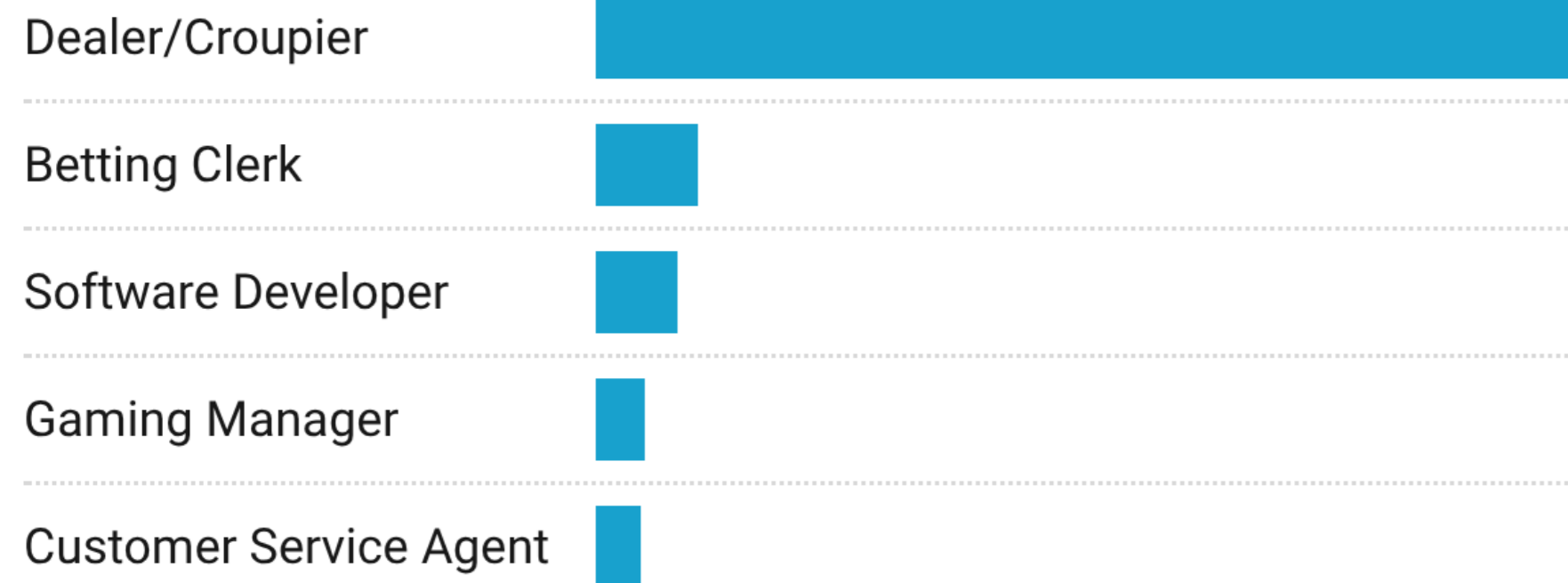

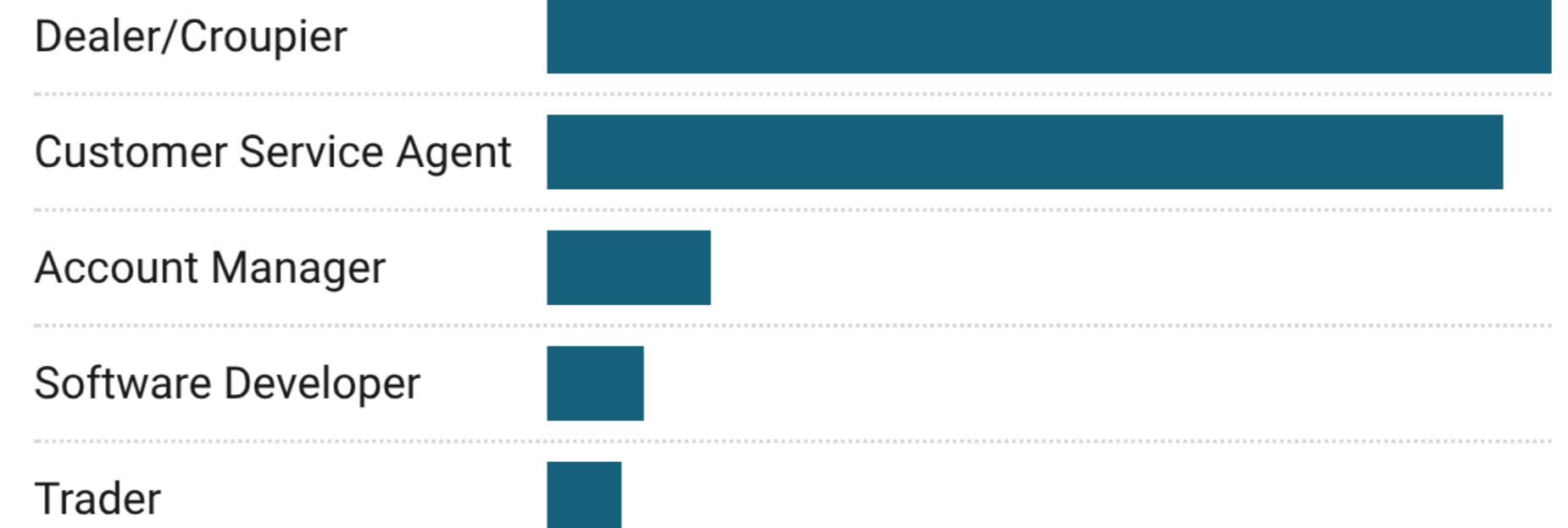

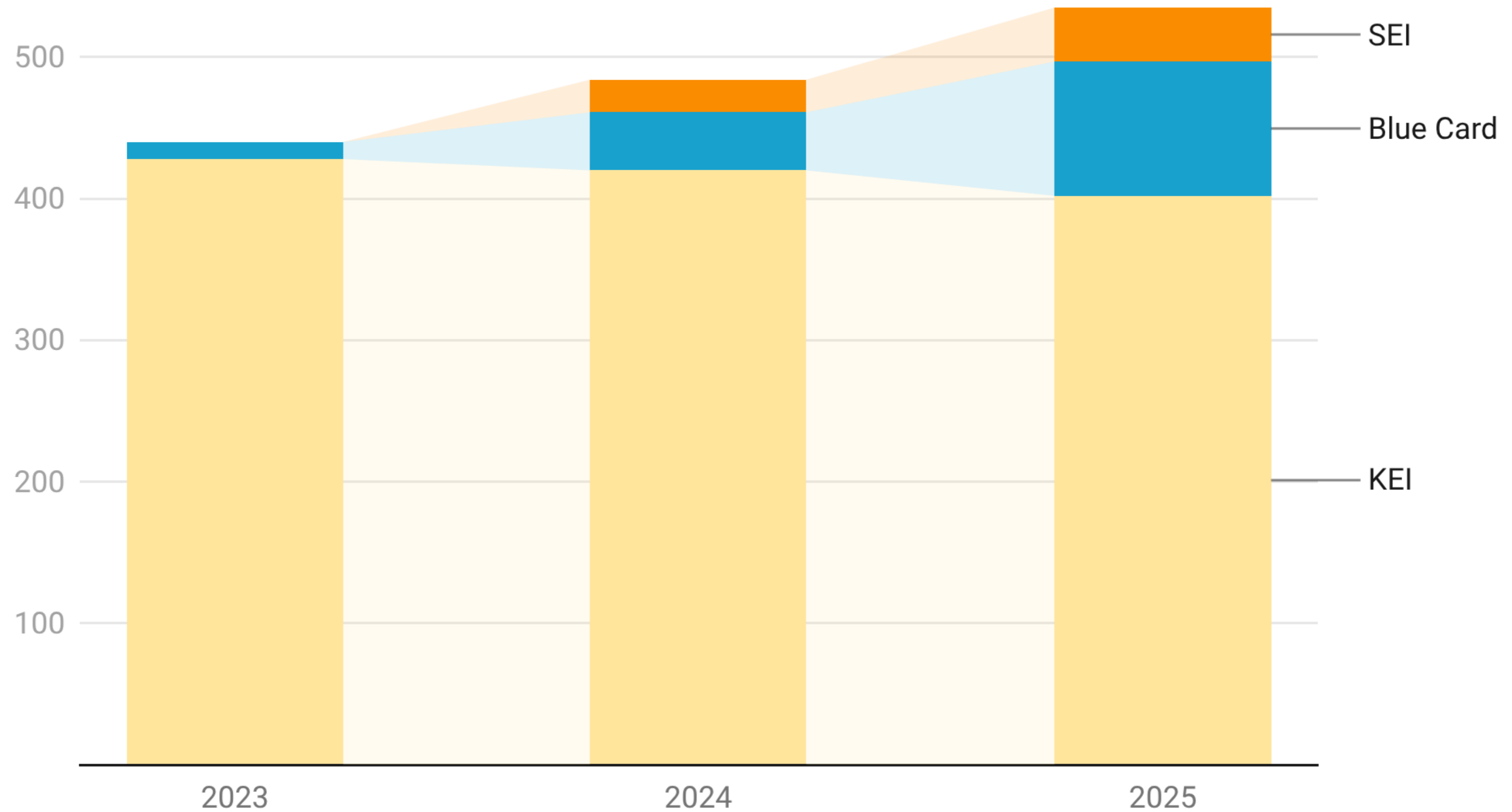

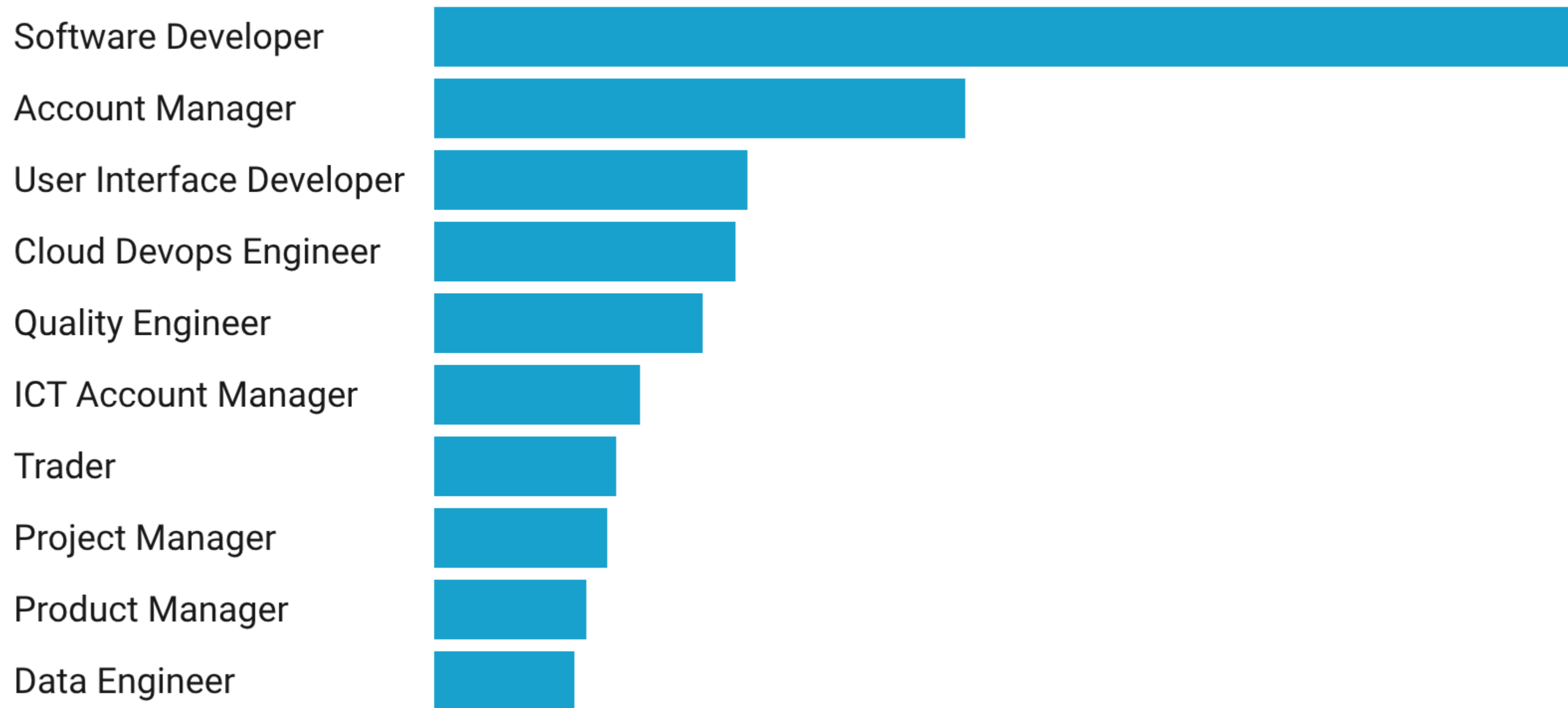

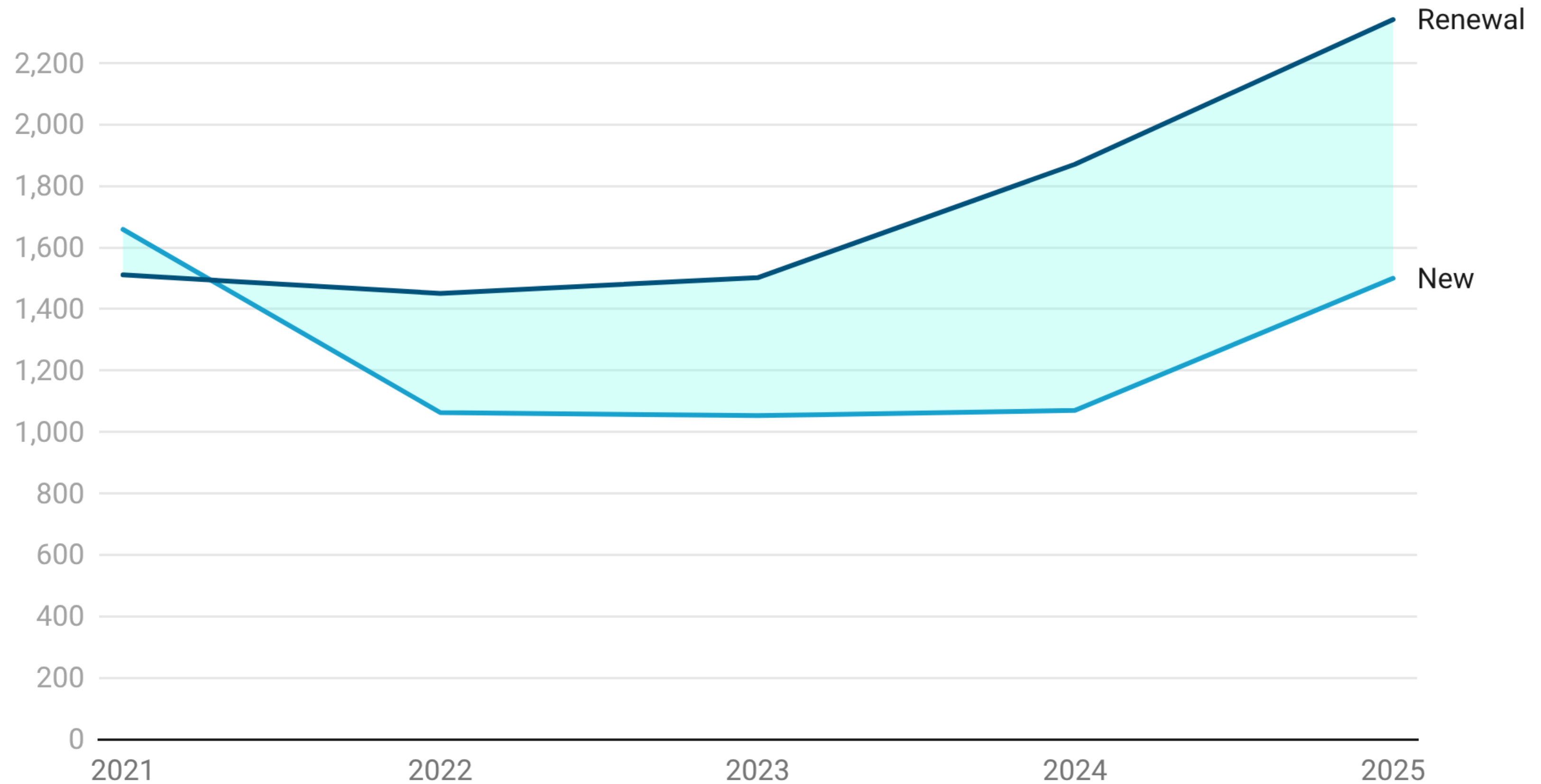

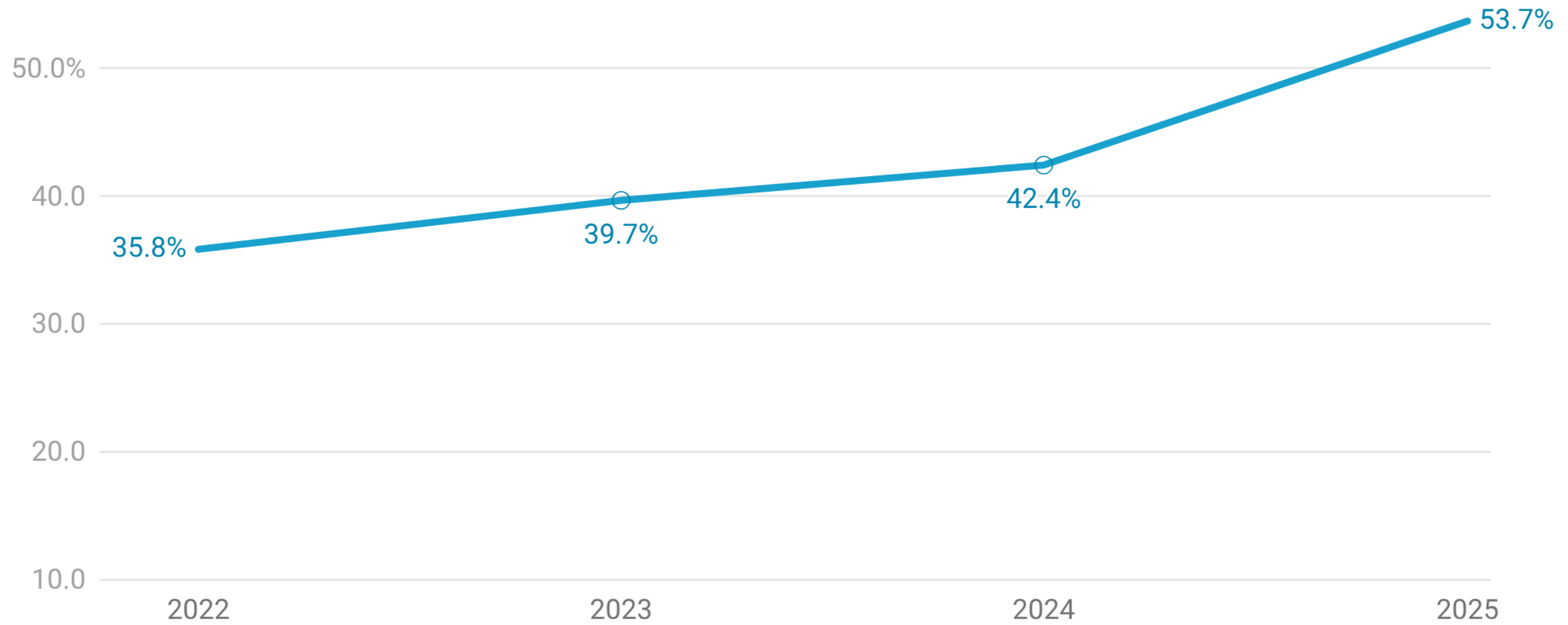

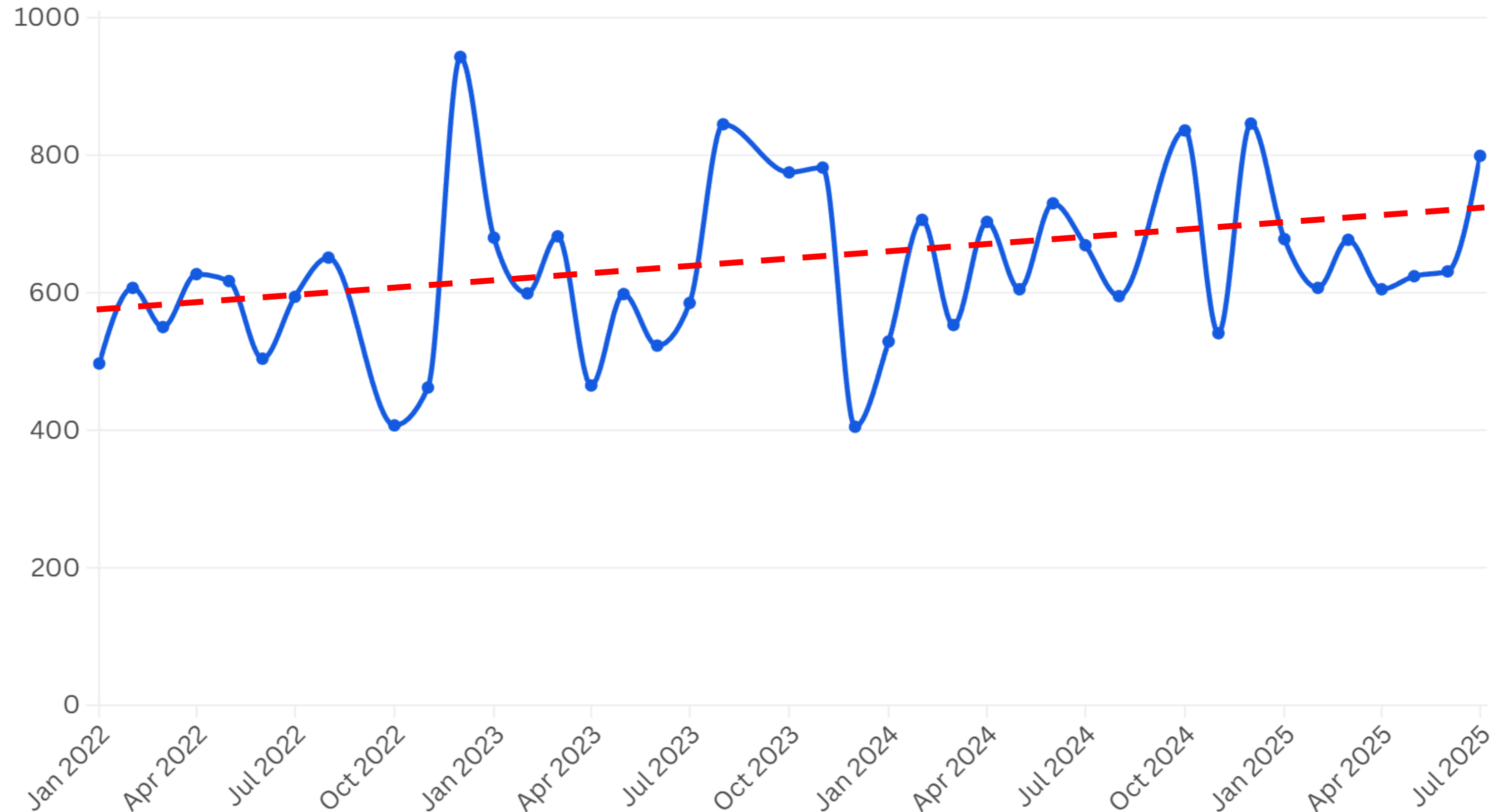

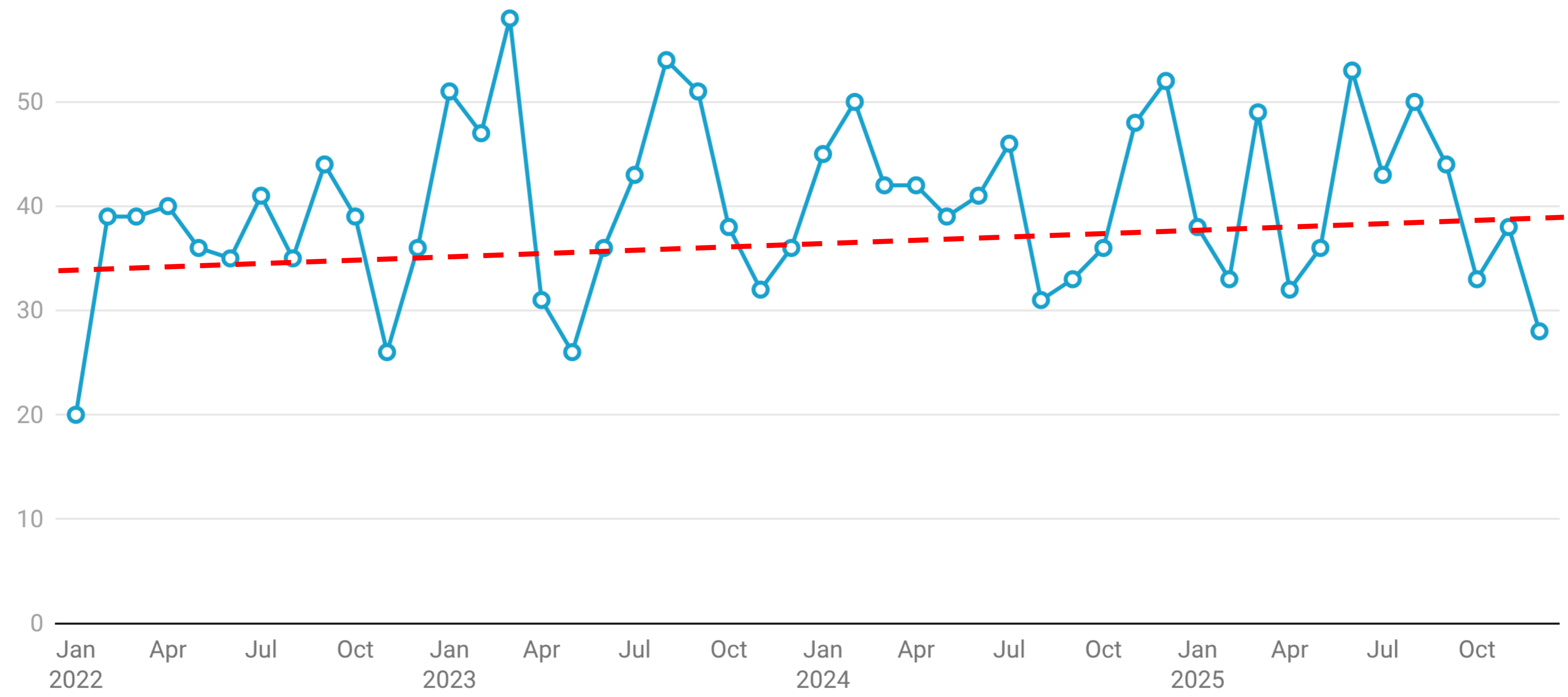

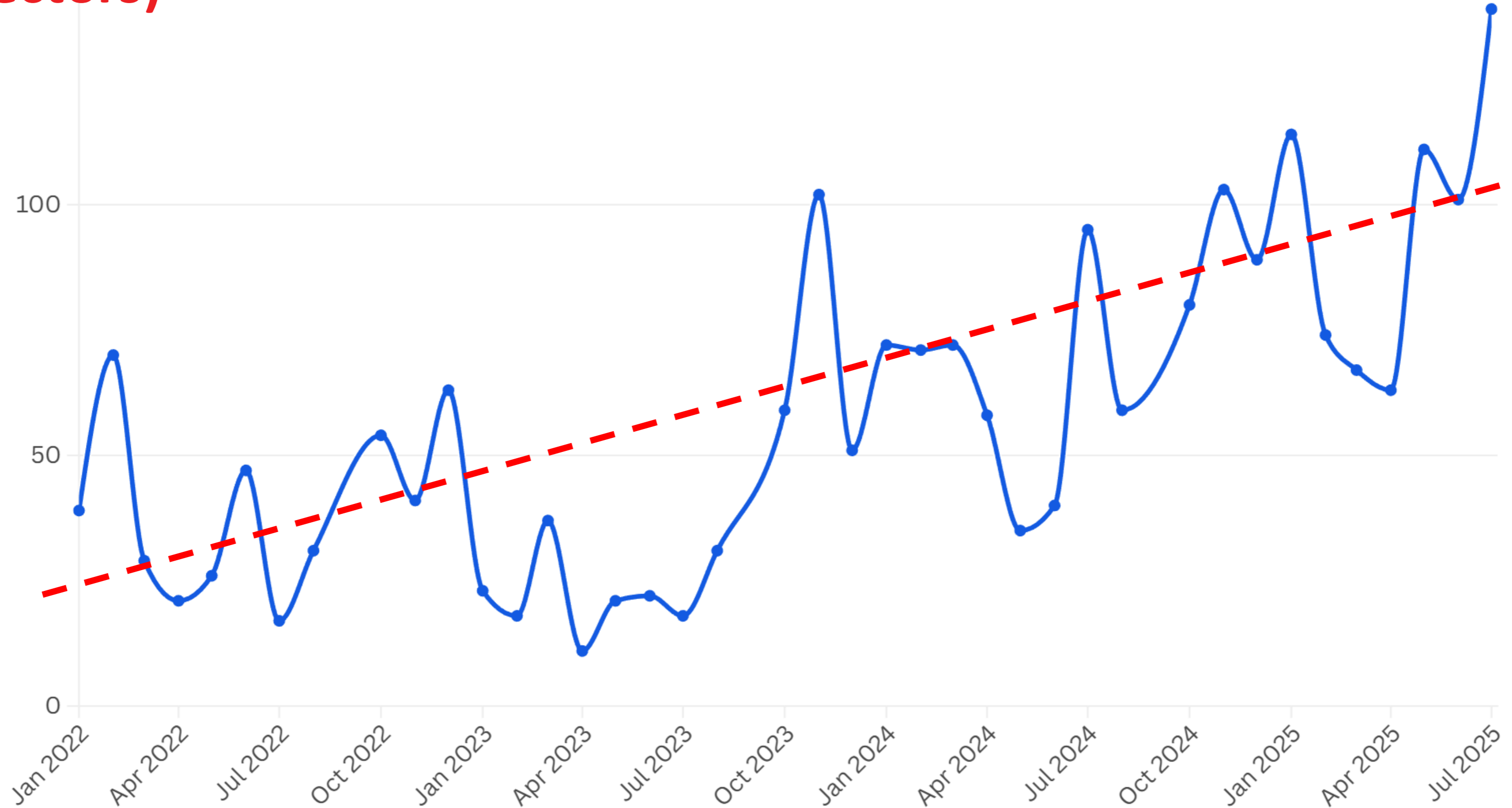
## Family Reunification Permits with a Working Sponsor (All Sectors)



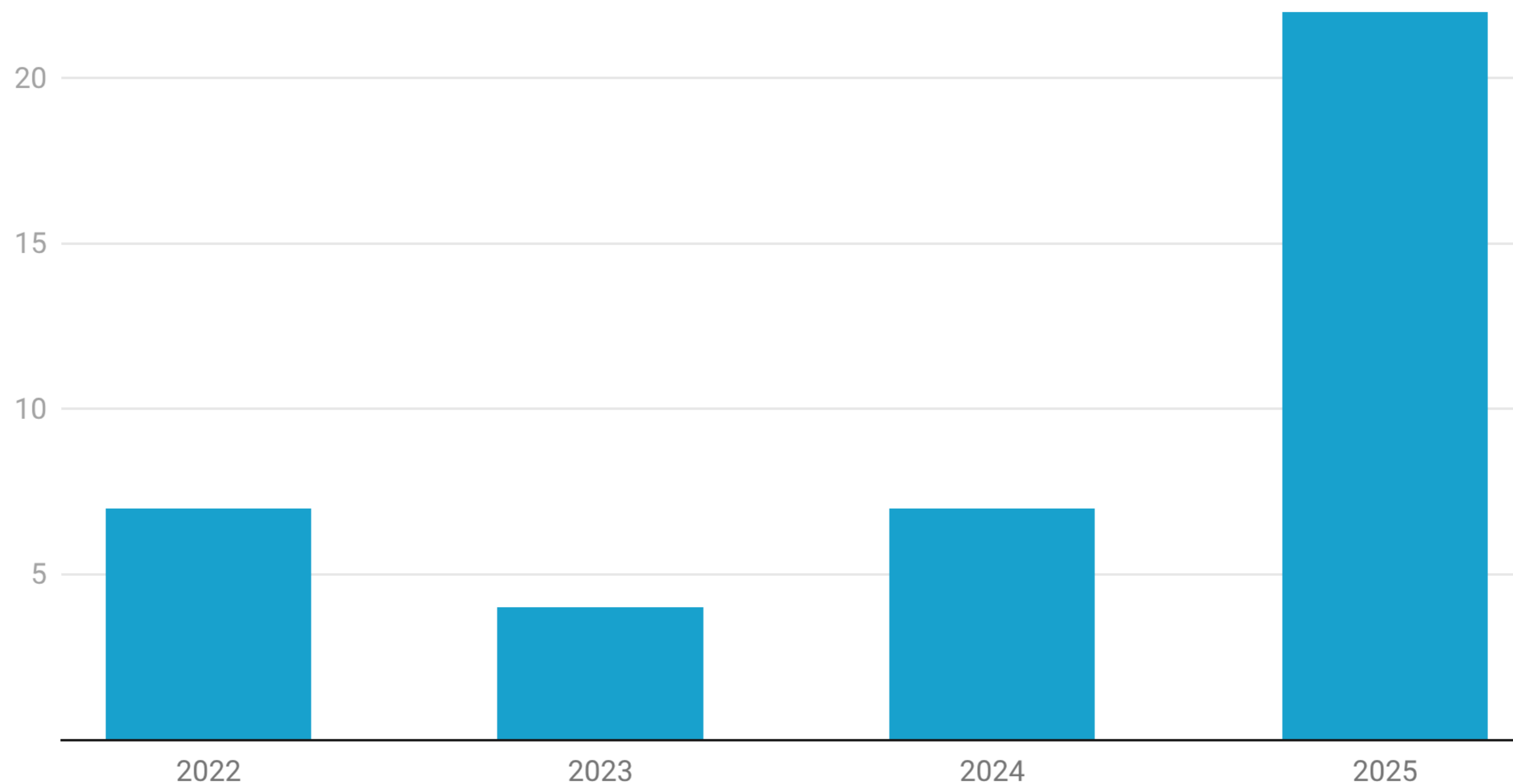

## Individuals with a previous study permit that turned to Employment (All Sectors)



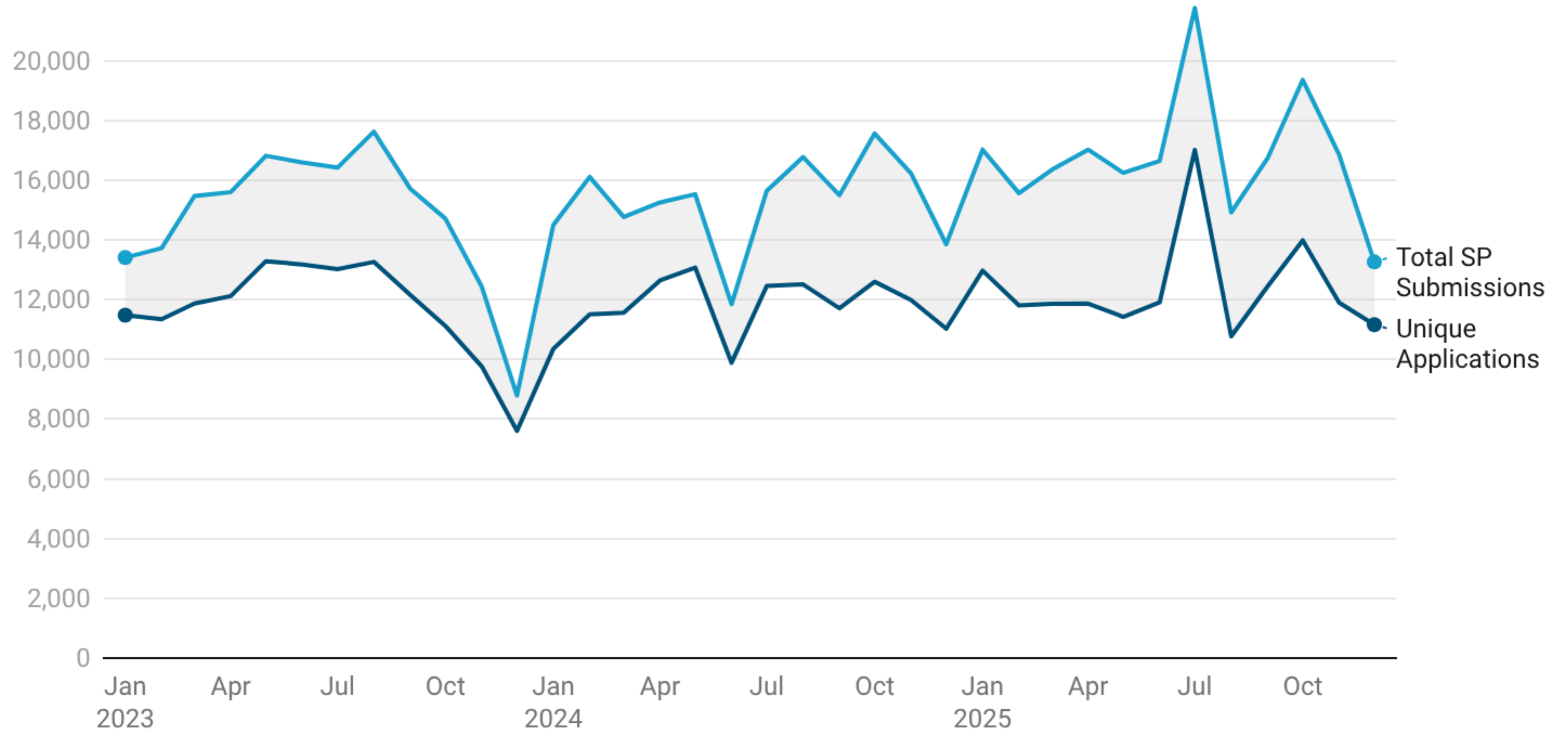

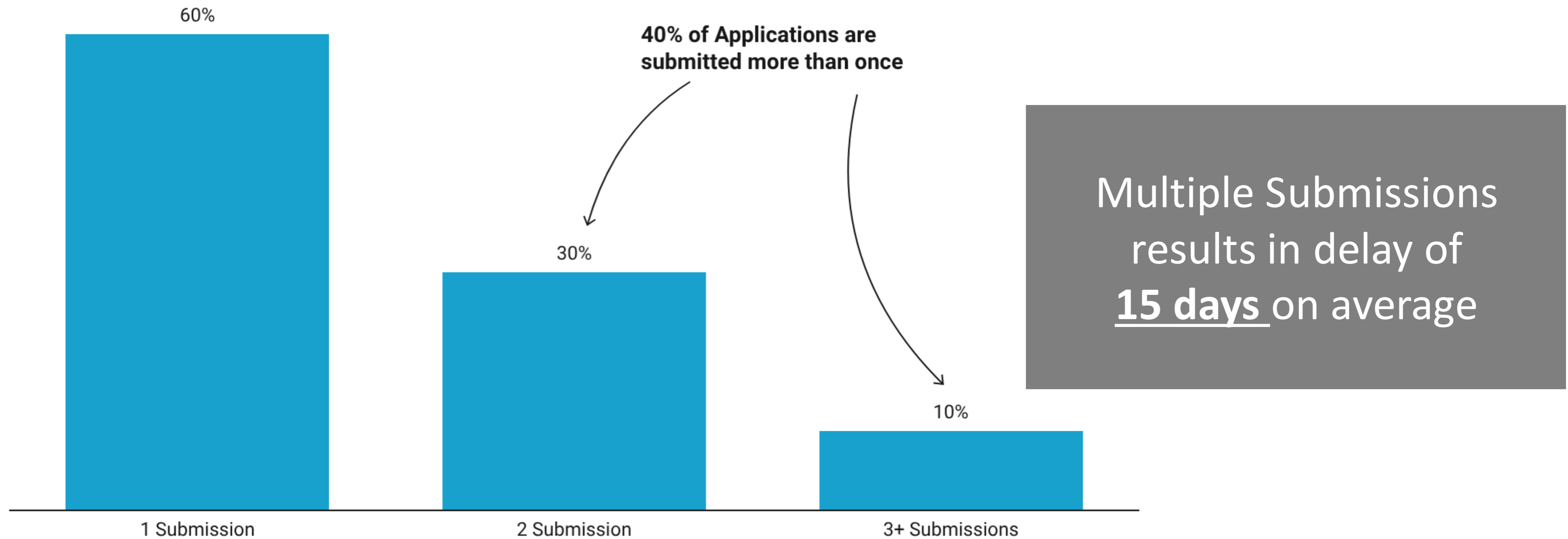

## Single Permit Applications vs Number of Submissions (All Sectors)

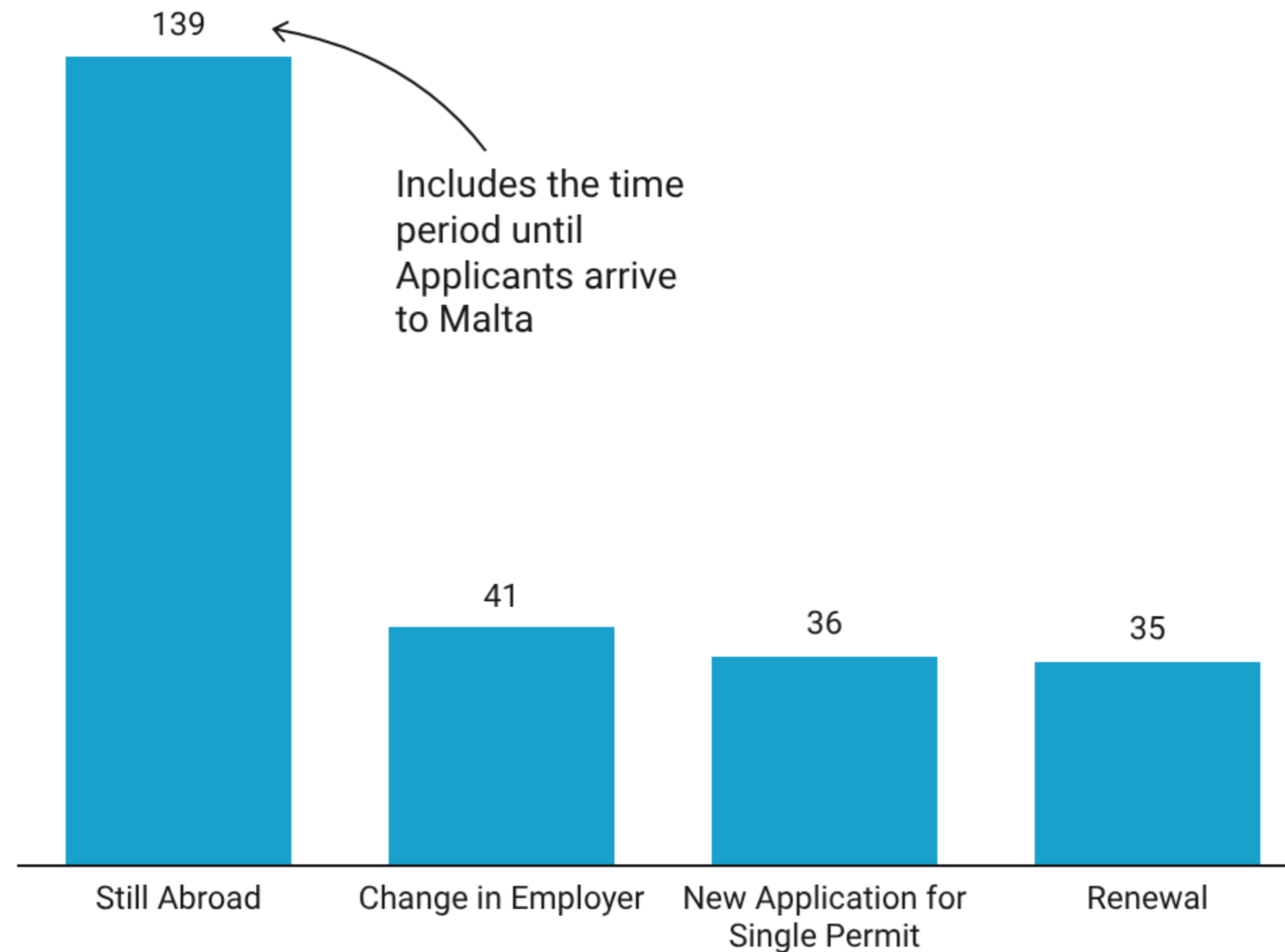


## % Proportion of Applications with 1 to 3+ submissions (All Sectors)
